This fully online program offers licensure and non-licensure options and can be completed in three years. You study civics and social systems while building skills in instruction, assessment, and real-world application, grounded in a Christ-centered approach.

### CAREER PATHWAYS

Graduates pursue roles as **middle and high school social studies teachers**. The licensure pathway prepares students for Wisconsin certification. The non-licensure option supports service in private and Lutheran schools. Graduates teach civics, history, and social sciences while helping students understand society and world around us.
