



## CTE INCENTIVE GRANTS CLASS OF 2021 CERTIFICATIONS LIST

The following is the list of CTE Technical Incentive Grant industry-recognized certifications available to high school students in the workforce shortage career clusters. Developed in cooperation between the Department of Workforce Development (DWD), Department of Public Instruction (DPI), and Wisconsin Technical College System Office (WTCS), these certifications take into account certifying agency recognition and validity, student accessibility, and programmatic rigor.

The certifications fall into five categories:

- 1. State Certified Work-Based Learning Programs- DPI Cooperative Education Skill Standards (Skills Co-Op),
- 2. State Certified Work-Based Learning Programs- DWD Youth Apprenticeship (YA),
- 3. Business & Industry Recognized Certifications,
- 4. Wisconsin Technical College Certifications,
- 5. Wisconsin Certified Pre-Apprenticeship Programs.

This list is revised annually to ensure relevance to current industry needs.
