Ladies and Gentlemen:

The BMO Harris Bradley Center at 1001 North Fourth Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, will be permanently closing due to the opening of the new Milwaukee Bucks Arena. Closing operations will commence on August 10, 2018, and are expected to be completed by September 7, 2018. The entire Center will be shut down, and if the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act and the Wisconsin plant closing law were to apply, the closing might be considered a plant or business closing or a mass layoff for purposes of such laws.

The BMO Harris Bradley Center's closing will result in the elimination of 45 full-time and 606 part-time jobs. The separation date for most employees is expected to be August 10, 2018. Separated employees will be paid for all accrued wages and vacation (if any) on that date. A few employees will remain to complete the actions necessary for the building closing and transfer of property to the Wisconsin Center District by August 31, 2018, and thereafter fewer than 8 employees will remain to manage the dissolution and wind down of the Bradley Center Sports and Entertainment Corporation, a tax-exempt instrumentality of the State of Wisconsin.

No union represents the employees affected by the closing and there are no "bumping rights."
