

Your Free Ticket to Work Services

There are programs other than DVR that are able to help you find or keep a job.

Because you receive Social Security monthly benefits, you have a Ticket to Work from the Social Security Administration (SSA). Your Ticket is not a piece of paper; it is connected to your Social Security number.

You may be able to use your Ticket to receive services from an Employment Network (EN) to help you find or keep a job. Employment Networks are service providers, education and training programs, government agencies, and employers approved by Social Security to help you find or keep a job.
