**2021 Seasonal Agricultural Migrants and H-2A Workers in Wisconsin**

Wis. Stat. 103.90-103.97 provides protections for migrant workers who temporarily leave their principal, out-of-state residence and come to Wisconsin for not more than 10 months in a year to accept seasonal employment in agriculture, horticulture, or food processing.\*

\*\*Non-workers are non-working family members of protected migrant seasonal farmworkers, as reported by employers. The non-worker population does not represent the total number of non-workers in the state.

^H-2A workers are foreign workers who arrived in Wisconsin to fill temporary agricultural jobs. Employers obtained certification from DOL after they demonstrated there were insufficient qualified U.S. workers available and willing to perform the work at wages that meet or exceed the prevailing wage paid for that occupation in the area of intended employment.

If an H-2A employer did not report the number of actual H-2A workers who arrived, the number of H-2A workers approved by DOL was used in this report.

The data provided in this report is a record of the Department's outreach and enforcement activities and does not purport to provide comprehensive data about the migrant farmworkers in Wisconsin.
