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# BLS Data: Wisconsin Adds 5,300 Total Non-Farm, 5,200 Private-Sector Jobs in January

MADISON – The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) today released the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) preliminary employment estimates for the month of January 2020. The data shows that Wisconsin added 5,300 total non-farm and 5,200 private-sector jobs in the month of January. Wisconsin's labor force participation rate in January was 66.9 percent, and the state's unemployment rate was 3.5 percent.

- Place of Residence Data: Wisconsin's labor force participation rate in January was 66.9, 3.5 percent higher than the national rate of 63.4 percent. Wisconsin's unemployment rate in January was 3.5 percent, 0.1 percent lower than the national rate of 3.6 percent.
- Place of Work Data: Wisconsin added 5,200 private-sector and 5,300 total non-farm jobs from December 2019 to January 2020. From January 2019 to January 2020, Wisconsin added 5,700 private-sector jobs and 6,200 total non-farm jobs.

"In Governor Evers' first year, Wisconsin added private sector jobs while unemployment remained at historic lows. Into year two and beyond, DWD and the Evers Administration will continue to work with partners throughout Wisconsin to create and enhance workforce initiatives to provide in-demand skills, remove barriers, increase wages, and strengthen family-supporting career opportunities," DWD Secretary Caleb Frostman said.
